

# Rover training: step by step



Congratulations, you've just been appointed Crew Leader! Or maybe you have another reason for undertaking Rover training. Either way, the process is simple and straightforward.

1. Attend or complete an Introductory Interview

You'll need the W1 Adult Membership form, the M5 VSD Form, and the L8 Intro Interview Completion form. Cost: \$60.

2. Wait for your e-Learning log in to arrive, and the sign in

Your log in could take a few weeks to arrive. Contact your Region Office if it seems to be taking more than 3 weeks.

3. Complete e-Learning: Basic Core Module & Basic Sectional Techniques for Rovers

You could do this over a couple of days, but aim to complete both sections within 3 months. The sooner the better!

4. Book into & attend a Rover Basic Sectional Techniques course.

These run over 2 days, and cover the practical topics that e-Learning can't cover. Cost is \$50 to \$180. Need a course? Ask your RRC.

4. Complete In Service for Rovers & hand in your paperwork.

That's the L10 form. You'll also need the L15 Basic Completion form, and a W3 to transfer into the Crew Leader (Resp) role.

The whole process should take 3-6 months on average from start to finish. Your RRC Training Officer or PLA can provide additional support and information.
